

# Download Across Genres First Grade

First, we make sure students know about and understand the different genres. The genres we study are: fiction, nonfiction, mystery, poetry, biography, and fantasy. We create an anchor chart as a class that allows students to sort pretend book covers into the different genres. This unit focuses on helping first graders transition from "learning to read" to "reading to learn". This unit positions readers to apply all they have learned about reading different genres across the year to learning about a topic across different genres. In addition to teaching students to world-solve and monitor for meaning on their first reads, you will want to encourage them to reread to ...

Writing: 1st Grade. Once your child has mastered writing letters and begins to improve her spelling skills, she can begin to write longer pieces in a variety of genres. First grade is that magical time in which your child progresses from simply writing words to becoming a "writer," and her spelling skills will improve in the meantime.
